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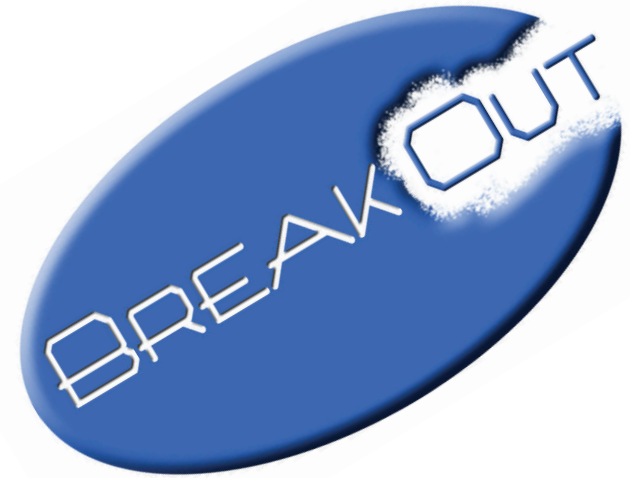

WHAT IS BREAK OUT ALL ABOUT?

Breakout is designed to move your child toward spiritual maturity. It uses a four part curriculum that will help them to Know Christ (3rd Grade), Grow in Christ (4th Grade), Serve Christ (5th Grade) and Share Christ (6th Grade).

What Is In Each Book?

Each year-long book consists of twenty-four lessons. Each month students will complete 3 lessons working in class and at home with their parents. *It's a great way for parents and children to grow closer together while growing in the Lord!*

What Is In Each Lesson?

Each lesson has three sections designed to move children from knowing something to doing something. Students are given thought-provoking questions and fun activities to reinforce the Christian values of lesson.

Working with your pre-teen now can deepen your relationship and help you relate to them spiritually.

Why Grades 3-6?

Upper elementary is a crucial stage in children's spiritual life because that is when they begin to develop their own sense of what it means to follow Christ. An emphasis on salvation and biblical understanding is key at this age because they are beginning to make their own choices. Our goal is to show them the way of Christ, help them discover the gifts He has given them, and equip them to serve Him both now and in the future.

What Is the Cost?

The cost is \$30.00 for each year-long session. That cost includes: the Student Book, Family Take-Home lessons, snacks and prizes. We are offering an Early Registration rate of \$25.00 to all families who register by December 1st. While these costs are important to ensure quality materials, no child will ever be turned away. Please speak with Pastor Anders or Bridget Aureli if the cost is a financial hardship for you.

When Is Break Out?

Classes meet once a month during Saturday Night Worship (7:00-8:30 p.m.). Our first meeting is **January 19, 2008**. Children and parents are encouraged to complete monthly homework in between each meeting. Sessions run for eight months.
