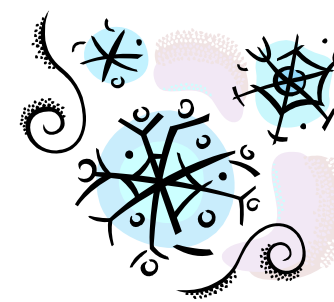

We decorated with flags representing our different nationalities and performed "This Little Light of Mine."



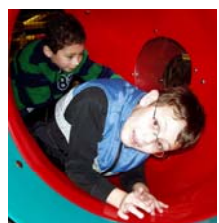
On February 16th the Kids' Place families celebrated our diversity with a pot-luck supper. Yum!



The kids presented their "I Have a Dream" artwork. This piece was by Marley.

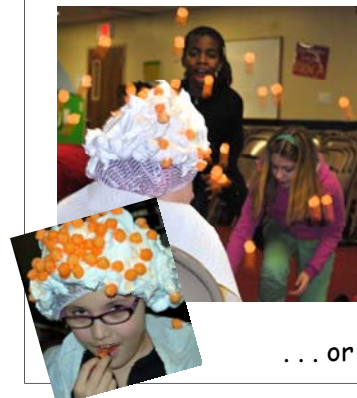
February Vacation Week!
